EVERGREEN VINEYARD, ANCIENT LAKES

One of the great and most distinctive vineyards of Washington State, Evergreen Vineyard is situated high above the Missoula Flood Plains and only grows white grape varietals. Wonderful acidity and pure fruit characterize its grapes. The site is very cool; the caliche and basalt in these ancient soils produce some of the best and most unique wines in the state, if not the world.

- 100% Riesling
- 100% stainless fermentation
- 58% Vin 13 Yeast
- 42% RHST Yeast
- Hand sorted
- Harvested October 29th

- 100% Evergreen Vineyard

ANALYSIS

- pH 3.09
- TA 0.92g/100ml
- Residual Sugar: 1.58 g/100ml
- 12.25% alcohol

“This Riesling has an unbelievable sense of balance, opening up with white peach, honeysuckle and a beautiful lift from deeper mineral/slate notes. It passes across the palate with wonderful acidity and texture, finishing with a lovely attack of granny smith apple, mandarin orange, and persimmon.
