CHENIN BLANC | YAKIMA VALLEY AVA 2024

WINEMAKING NOTES

Sourced from a new spot this year, the Holmanson/Lyendecker vineyard in Yakima Valley AVA, this wine was cold-settled to enhance clarity and purity. Fermented in a combination of concrete and stainless steel, then racked to concrete, this process emphasizes the wine's minerality and creates a well-balanced, easy-drinking white wine.

TASTING NOTES

The nose on 2024 Adrienne reveals the minerality of the vineyard's rocks and soil. The palate bursts with bright lemon zest, notes of citrus marmalade, with a slight sweetness reminiscent of pineapple upside-down cake. The finish is long and clean, and with a low alcohol content, this helps making for an approachable, refreshing wine.

ABOUT THE VINEYARD

The Holmanson / Lyendecker Vineyard, situated in the Yakima Valley AVA, is celebrated for its unique terroir that shapes the character of the wines produced here. As part of the Sagemoor Vineyards collection, known for its premium grape-growing since 1972, this vineyard thrives in the region's combination of sunny, warm days and cooler nights. These conditions support the slow, even ripening of grapes, which results in wines with rich complexity and flavor. The vineyard's focus on sustainable farming practices ensures that the fruit reflects the true essence of the Yakima Valley.
